- F. RULES AND REGULATIONS - REPORT**  
**Final Rules/Amendments: Occupational Therapy:** The Board received a request to consider alternatives to the limit on the number of examination attempts currently permitted by its rules for licensure as an occupational therapist. Following discussion, the Board requested that a draft be prepared for its review. A draft of the proposed amendments was considered by the Board at its December 2012 and January and February 2013 meetings and additional recommendations were suggested. A revised draft was presented for review and consideration at its March 2013 meeting. Following review and discussion, the Board voted to provide *Notice of Intent* to adopt the rule amendments. Said *Notice of Intent* appeared in the August 2013 edition of the *Louisiana Register*. No comments were received by the Board during the comment period. The rule amendments became final upon promulgation in the December 2013 edition of the *Louisiana Register*. **Physicians and Surgeons – Dispensing:** During its February 2013 meeting, the Board gave consideration to a request to provide for dispensation registration for non-controlled substances following a physician's completion of a graduate medical education training program and passage of an online or other Board-offered course on dispensing. Following discussion, the Board requested that a draft amendment to Section §6513 of its dispensing rules be included on its March 2013 agenda. Following review and discussion of a draft amendment to Section §.6513 of its dispensing rules, during the March 2013 meeting, the Board voted to provide *Notice of Intent* to adopt the rule amendment. Said *Notice of Intent* appeared in the August 2013 edition of the *Louisiana Register*. No comments were received by the Board during the comment period. The amendments became final upon promulgation in the December 2013 edition of the *Louisiana Register*. **Physicians and Surgeons – Licensure:** The Board expressed a desire to consider alternatives to the requirement of the passage of SPEX/COMVEX-USA for those who had taken and passed a written medical competency examination more than 10 years prior to the date of application. A draft was considered at the December 2012 meeting and following review of various options at its January and February 2013 meetings, the Board made additional recommendations and requested that a revised draft be returned to the agenda for

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consideration. Following review and discussion at the March 2013 meeting, the Board voted to provide *Notice of Intent* to adopt the amendments. Said *Notice of Intent* appeared in the August 2013 edition of the *Louisiana Register*. One comment was received during the comment period and was considered by the Board during its September 2013 meeting. The Board's response to the comment is included in the legislative report. The amendment was adopted upon promulgation in the December 2013 edition of the *Louisiana Register*.

**Physicians and Surgeons – Out of State Physician Orders:** Pursuant to Act 44 of the 2011 session of the Louisiana legislature, rules were developed to accommodate out-of-state physicians (those licensed in any state other than Louisiana) who order routine diagnostic testing for established patients in this state provided: the physician-patient relationship was initiated through in-person, face-to-face visit with the physician in another state; the order can be verified; and the results of all testing are provided directly to the ordering out-of state physician. Drafts were considered by the Board at its December 2012 and January 2013 meetings during which the Board made additional recommendations. Following review and discussion of various options at its February 2013 meeting, the Board requested that a revised draft be returned to the March 2013 meeting. Following review and discussion of the revised draft at the March 2013 meeting, the Board voted to provide *Notice of Intent* to adopt the rule amendments. Said *Notice of Intent* appeared in the August 2013 edition of the *Louisiana Register*. No comments were received by the Board during the comment period. The amendments were adopted upon promulgation in the December 2013 edition of the *Louisiana Register*.

**Polysomnography:** The Board received a proposed draft of new rules for polysomnographers from its advisory committee on polysomnography. A revised draft was presented to the advisory committee for its review and comments. The draft was approved with suggestions for modification during the Committee's meeting on September 16, 2011. During its October 2011 meeting, the proposed rules were presented to the Board along with the Committee's suggestions for initial review and discussion. Following discussion, the Board proposed certain modifications to the draft and asked that a revised draft be presented at its next meeting. The Board subsequently received nearly identical suggestions as those of the Committee's from two national organizations. During the December 2011 meeting, the Board approved a response to the Committee and organizations, along with a revised draft of proposed rule amendments that incorporated the suggestions of its staff, as well as the Committee and the organizations to the extent the Board found them acceptable, and voted to provide *Notice of Intent* to adopt the amendments. Given changes to the law during the 2012 session of the Legislature, a revised draft of rules was presented to the Board for review and consideration at its April 2013 meeting. Following review and discussion during its July 2013 meeting, the Board voted to provide *Notice of Intent* to adopt the rules. Said *Notice of Intent* appeared in the September 2013 edition of the *Louisiana Register*. One comment was received during the comment period and was considered by the Board during its October 2013 meeting. The Board's response to the comment is included in the legislative report. The amendments were adopted upon promulgation in the December 2013 edition of the *Louisiana Register*.

**Physicians and Surgeons – Collaborative Drug Therapy Management ("CDTM"):** During its August 2012 meeting, the Board discussed the concept of certain potential amendments to the existing rules which were jointly promulgated with the Louisiana Board of Pharmacy in 2007. The Board expressed a willingness to consider a draft of the proposed suggestions in due course. Following discussions with a representative of the Louisiana State Board of Pharmacy, a draft detailing proposed amendments to the rules was submitted for initial Board review and discussion at its April 2013 meeting. The Board discussed the proposed amendments during its May and June 2013 meetings and suggested modifications. Following review and discussion of a revised draft during its July 2013 meeting, the Board voted to provide *Notice of Intent* to adopt the amendments. Said *Notice of Intent* appeared in the September 2013 edition of the *Louisiana Register*. No comments were received by the Board during the comment period. The amendments were adopted upon promulgation in the December 2013 edition of the *Louisiana Register*.

**Rules/Amendments: Noticed for Intent:** None published since the last meeting of the Board.

**Rules/Amendments under Development: Perfusionists:** The Perfusion Advisory Committee prepared an initial draft of administrative rules for this category of allied health care professionals. A revised draft was received and studied. Following a number of revisions

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to conform the rules to the law and review by staff, a revised draft was forwarded to the Committee Chair for review. The Committee's chair had no additional suggestions for revision or modification. A draft of the rules was presented for initial consideration at the September 2013 meeting. Following review and discussion, the Board voted to provide *Notice of Intent to Intent* to adopt the rules at its October 2013 meeting. It is anticipated that such *Notice of Intent* will appear in the February edition of the *Louisiana Register*. **Physicians and Surgeons – Office-Based Surgery:** The Board considered suggestions for amendment of its office-based surgery rules. A revised draft incorporating the suggested changes was considered and further suggestions were presented in a revised draft. Following review and discussion, the Board voted to provide *Notice of Intent* to adopt the rule amendments. Prior to publication of said *Notice of Intent*, staff suggested additional changes at its August 2013 meeting relative to the performance of office-based procedures using moderate or conscious sedation. Pursuant to the Board's instructions, a revised draft was presented for further consideration incorporating suggested changes and modification at its December 2013 meeting. **Midwifery:** Given changes to the Louisiana Midwifery Practice Act during the 2012 session of the Legislature, staff anticipates presenting revisions to its existing rules in due course for the Board's consideration and discussion. **Physicians and Surgeons – Unprofessional Conduct:** During its April 2013 meeting, the Board expressed a desire to consider the development of rules correlating a physician representing himself or herself as a specialist in a particular field of practice with appropriate formal training in that field. Pursuant to the Board's direction, a draft of such rules was prepared for initial review and consideration. The draft also includes a prohibition against a physician prescribing of controlled substances to one's self or immediate family members in the absence of an emergency. A draft was submitted for the Board's review at its August and September 2013 meetings. At its October meeting, the Board determined to defer that part of the proposed rule dealing with self-prescribing and to provide *Notice of Intent* to adopt the amendments on unprofessional conduct in the *Louisiana Register*. **Physicians and Surgeons – Collaborating Physicians:** The Board expressed a desire to consider the development of rules relative to physicians who collaborate with advanced practice registered nurses. A draft was prepared by staff for initial review and consideration at its October 2013 meeting. A revised draft incorporating comments and suggestions was considered by the Board at its December 2013 meeting following which the Board elected to preview the draft to several professional organizations (LSMS, LMA, and LAFP) and the Louisiana State Board of Nursing.
